Devi Worship and Navaratri

During the $\dot{s}arad$ $\dot{r}tu$, in the month of Ashwin, in the $\dot{S}ukla$ $pak\dot{s}a$, Pratipada to $Navam\bar{\iota}$ (1st to 9th day after the new moon) we pray to the glory of this entire manifestation of $\bar{I}\dot{s}vara$ in the form of his Shakti, in and through the different forms of Devi. We celebrate the 9 glorious nights full of devotion and prayer, the Navaratri.

This sacred period is the celebration of Dharma over Adharma reflected in the

powerful episode of Devi Durga battling *Mahiṣāsura*, to restore Dharma. It is also the time that celebrates the victory of Bhagavan Rama over Ravana. Generally each night is dedicated to one aspect of Durga Devi, she who removes pain & sorrow. She bestows courage, strength & helps us to face any challenge in life.



In the ch9.10 of the Bhagavad Gita, Bhagavan says,

मयाऽध्यक्षेण प्रकृतिः सूयते सचराचरम्।

mayādhyakṣeṇa prakṛtiḥ sūyate sacarācaram |

'With me as the presiding presence, the prakriti creates the world of movable and immovables.'

Thus, Prakriti, Maya, Shakti, Devi, is a manifested form of the Purusha, Brahman and without whose presiding presence, Prakriti will have no existence at all.

The first verse of Soundaryalahari says:

शिवः शक्त्या युक्तो यदि भवति शक्तः प्रभवितुं

न चेदेवं देवो न खलु कुशलः स्पन्दितुमपि।

śivaḥ śaktyā yukto yadi bhavati śaktaḥ prabhavitum

na cedevam devo na khalu kuśalah spanditumapi 1

Parameśvara is capable of manifesting as the universe, only when united with Shakti, else he is not capable of even a stir. At the same time, Shakti has no existence independent of *Parameśvara*.

So, our $namask\bar{a}ra$ again and again to that Devi (the manifested form of $\bar{I}\dot{s}vara$), who is in and through in all beings and is called $Visnum\bar{a}y\bar{a}$ and is reflected as Consciousness.

She abides in the form of Intelligence buddhi बुद्धि, Sleep nidrā निद्रा, Hunger kṣudhā क्षुधा, Shadow chāyā छाया (Jīvātmā as a shadow of Paramātmā), Power shakti (शक्ति), Thirst tṛṣṇā तृष्णा, Forbearance kṣanti क्षान्ति, Genus jāti जाति, Modesty lajjā लज्जा, Peace śānti शान्ति, Śraddhā अद्धा, Loveliness and Beauty kānti क्यान्ति, Good Fortune Lakshmi (लक्ष्मी) Thought yrtti त्रित

Beauty *kānti* कान्ति, Good Fortune *Lakshmi* (लक्ष्मी), Thought *vṛtti* वृत्ति, Memory *smṛti* स्मृति, Kindness *dayā* दया, Contentment *tuṣṭi* तुष्टि,

Motherhood *mātr* ਸੀਰ and even

Delusion bhrānti भ्रान्ति.

Namaskāra to the Devi who governs the faculty of senses of beings in all the worlds, who always pervades all beings and the universe in the form of Consciousness and abides in it.

इन्द्रियाणामधिष्ठात्री भूतानां चाखिलेषु या। भूतेषु सततं तस्यै व्याप्ति देव्यै नमो नमः॥ चितिरूपेण या कृत्स्नमेतद्याप्य स्थिता जगत् नमस्तस्यै, नमस्तस्यै,नमस्तस्यै नमोनमः॥

indriyāṇāmadhiṣṭhātrī bhūtānāṃ cākhileṣu yā | bhūteṣu satataṃ tasyai vyāpti devyai namonamaḥ || citirūpeṇa yā kṛtsnametadvyāpya sthitā jagat | namastasyai, namastasyai namonamaḥ ||

When every form is the form of Devi, we see the entire world as her form, the mother who is taking care of us every moment. We have been in her lap, loved and protected, since we were born. In the form of the 5 elements (space to live, air to breathe, fire, water and food to survive) she has provided us all that we need for our growth. We have been, are being and will be taken care of by her. We see her glories, her beauty, her care in every moment of our lives through her grosser and subtler forms. Being able to even read these words is her glory. Thus, she resides in the entire world, resides in each of us and she is us.

Through maya shakti, the manifesting power of Brahman, we recognise her powers of $\bar{a}varaṇa$ and vikṣepa and see her in the form of $bhr\bar{a}nti$, delusion as well. At the same time, we see that she is the one who helps us cut through the $bhr\bar{a}nti$, by taking the form of Shruti $M\bar{a}t\bar{a}$, teaching us the truth of her existence and our existence which is the $adhiṣṭh\bar{a}nam$ of both her and us.



Depending on where we are on our spiritual journey, we can plan to use this sacred time to let go of old unhelpful patterns of thinking and behaving, gain a clearer vision and invoke grace and blessings for the path ahead. We open our hearts to receive grace in the form of courage and the power to crossover obstacles as Durga, abundance and the power to desire as Lakshmi and knowledge as Saraswati. Through the 9 nights of Navaratri, we move from darkness

towards light, from ignorance to knowledge.

The 9 nights of Navaratri are meant for intense prayers and worship. We eagerly look forward to express our devotion to the Devi through all our special ways. With a sincere and honest hearts, we connect to her through our intense Bhakti and she blesses us all in full abundance.
